

TEEN COURT CODE OF CONDUCT

All Teen Court Volunteers are required to understand and abide by the following Code of Conduct.

Upon your arrival to the Highlands County Courthouse, you are required to report to the Jury Assembly Room in the basement of the Courthouse.

- You are required to follow the Teen Court Dress For Success program. If you are not dressed properly you will not be allowed in the Courtroom.
- You are required to have the following documents on file with the coordinator before you can participate in the Teen Court Program:
 - A current Teen Court Application,
 - Oath of Confidentiality, and
 - Release of Information
- You are required to conduct yourself as a mature and respectful young person to all court personnel, as well as while in the Jury Deliberation Room.
- If your conduct is found to be unsatisfactory by any of the court personnel, the coordinator will contact you to deal with you accordingly.
